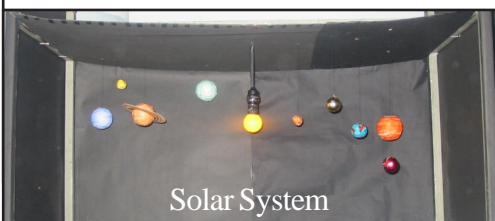
Students Achievements for 2005-06
